Privacy Statement



It is the policy and practice of Hamot Health Foundation, Hamot Second Century Fund to fully respect the privacy and confidentiality of our donors. To that end, we declare the following statements:

Gift Information

It is the policy and practice of Hamot Health Foundation to maintain confidentiality of gift amounts. Financial information is restricted to only designated Hamot Health Foundation employees. All record keeping software meets Hamot Health Foundation's security compliance standards. In publications, donors are recognized in alphabetical order according to the fund to which they designated their gift. On our Recognition Towers in the Medical Center, donors are recognized, with their permission, in level categories according to their lifetime giving.

Throughout all modes of donor recognition, requests for public anonymity are honored.

Donors may request, in writing, a review of their giving history including gift dates, amounts and designations. Such information will be mailed only to the donor and only to the address we have on record.

Personal Information

It is the policy and practice of Hamot Health Foundation to restrict access to all personal information about our donors, including names and addresses, to the regular course of Hamot business. Under no circumstances will names and addresses of our donors be released, sold or otherwise shared with agencies or persons not conducting regular and approved business on behalf of Hamot Health Foundation. Vendors and auditors must guarantee confidentiality of information submitted to them under contract for Hamot Health Foundation work. It is the policy and practice of Hamot Health Foundation to comply will all provisions of the federal government's Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA).
